Date of the publication and **Title** are self evident. Occasionally there may be additional words inserted in brackets in or by the Title to give a better understanding for today's reader of what was commonly implicit when the publication was written years ago.

Catalog Section is enclosed in parentheses and gives other information about the publication. This starts with the **Catalog Section** letter (A, B, C, or D) and the **Type of Publication** (Book, Pamphlet, Academic Paper, or Periodical), followed by other optional information used to locate a publication in its respective *Catalog Section* as outlined for the different sections as follows:

Section A will simply be (A: Book) when there is a single author. When a book has multiple authors, the author under whom it is catalogued is indicated as (A: Book. See: "XXXXX, XXX") giving the author's, or editor's, or compiler's last and first names.

Section B will simply be (B: Pamphlet in Box 'XXXXX') when there is a single author. XXXXX is the label of the Box containing the publication. When a Pamphlet has multiple authors or is part of a group, name under which it is catalogued is indicated as (B: Pamphlet Book. See: "XXXXX") giving the author's, editors, or compiler's name (or a non-individual such as a publisher).

Section C will be (C: Academic - 'XXXXX') giving the type of academic paper (ThD Dissertation, Research Paper, etc.).

Section D will be (D: Article - 'XXXXX') giving the name of the periodical/magazine (Baptist Herald, NAB today, etc.).

Note: As of Oct 20, 2016 the authors of Section D articles are in the process of being added to this Index.

2. *For users at the NAB Heritage Center, get the "Cameroon Mission History Collection – Catalog" binder and lift the relevant tab (A, B, C, or D).*

a. *For Books (Tab A), Pamphlets (Tab B), or Academic Papers (Tab C), read down to the desired author and year of publication.*

The actual Book, Pamphlet, or Academic Paper, can be retrieved from the A, B, or C shelves of the Cameroon Collection (Stack #4).

b. *For published Articles (Section D), read down (turning pages as needed) to the binder number –the "xx" in the "(D-xx:...)"– from the Index 1 listing. Then read down to the publication date and author name. The actual Article can be retrieved from the D shelf.*
